

James Ashwin Memorial Scholarship in Physiology update:

With the blessing of the family of James Ashwin and, at the suggestion of the Director, Dr. Abraham Thomas and the Head of Physiology, Dr. Sheena Singh, we have been revising the terms of the James Ashwin Scholarship. In our November meetings in Ludhiana, we asked the question, "What is the best way to encourage the study of Physiology at the post grad level?" The answer seemed to be: "fund the research projects that postgraduate students must complete in order to attain their degree in Physiology." This provision would not only encourage students but, because research is the backbone of Physiology, it would raise the awareness and reputation of the Physiology department. This, in turn, would provide additional incentive to study there.

We are nearing the completion of this process and hope that we will soon have a qualifying recipient, possibly in 2015.

Helen Flanagan Memorial Scholarship in Nursing update:
